STATE OF OHIO REMEDIATION SERVICES

- Priority to homes where children have been lead-poisoned and have lead hazard control orders.
- New applicants may be placed on a waiting list.

TAX CREDIT

- State income tax credit to Ohio property owners who incur qualifying lead abatement costs in connection with an eligible dwelling.
- The tax credit is capped at \$10,000.00 per taxpayer and per eligible dwelling.
